Guidelines for Half Yearly / Term I Exam 2021-22

1. Class X & XII

CBSE will conduct Term I Examination, in the month of Nov. Dec. 2021 (after 15th Nov. 2021) with 50% syllabus issued by CBSE. The Question Paper will have MCQs of different types, with 90 minutes duration & 40 marks CBSE will provide Q.P. & M.S. to the Centre. Students will use OMR Sheet for their response, which will be evaluated at the Centre and Marks uploaded same day on CBSE Portal or scanned copies of OMR sheet will be uploaded on CBSE Portal.

2. Class IX & XI

Term-I Examination will be conducted as Common Zonal Examination in the month of Oct-Nov 2021 with 50% rationalized syllabus provided by CBSE through offline mode. The Question Paper will be of MCQs of different types as per CBSE guidelines (Sample Paper 2021). It will be of 90 minutes duration and 40 marks. Question Paper will be provided to schools on behalf of CG Zone. Students will give their response on OMR Sheet which will be evaluated by school through OMR scanning / manually.

3. Class VIII

Half Yearly Examination 2021-22 will be Common Zonal Examination and will be conducted through offline mode in the month of Oct-Nov 2021, with 50% syllabus as circulated to schools recently. The Question Paper will be comprising of both subjective (30 Marks) & objective (10 Marks) as per the guidelines and sample paper issued by DAV CAE for class VIII Annual Examination 2021-22. It will be of 105 minutes duration (90 minutes writing time & 15 minutes reading time) & 40 marks question paper. 30 marks subjective question paper will be of SA & LA type questions and 10 Marks (objective) will be VSA. Blueprint of question paper will be provided to Question Paper Setter. Students will write in Answer Paper to be provided by school.

4. Class V, VI & VII: 2nd Periodic Test

Class V, VI & VII will be a Common Zonal Examination and will be conducted through offline mode in the month of Oct-Nov 2021, with syllabus of 2nd Periodic Test as circulated earlier. The question paper will be 40 marks (30marks Subjective 10 marks Objective) and 105 minutes duration (90 minutes writing time & 15 minutes reading time). 30 marks subjective question paper will be of SA & LA and 10 Marks objective will be VSA. Blueprint of question paper will be provided to Question Paper Setter. Students will write in Answer Paper to be provided by school.
